Wine Story

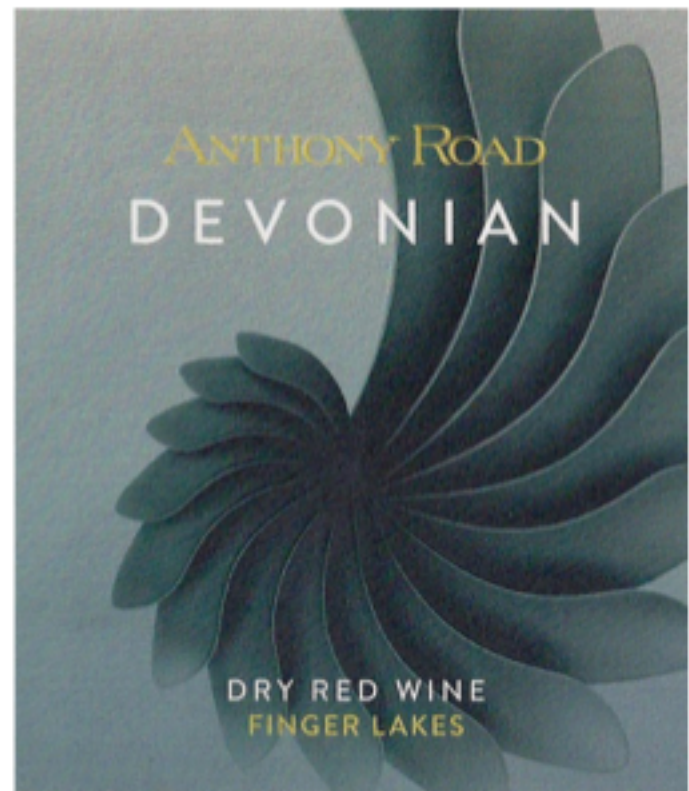
Devonian - a chapter of geological history in the Finger Lakes. Sedimentary rock from this period is the foundation of the soils in which our grapes grow and contributes to the uniqueness of our wines. The fossilized cephalopod depicted on the front is an example of life that was abundant during this period.

Winemaking Notes

Estate grown Cabernet Franc, Lemberger and Pinot Noir fruit are harvested for our Devonian Red. The goal is to produce a wine that is intriguing, fruit forward and approachable. Its lighter body and fresh flavor enable it to pair with most food preparations. Year in and year out, our Devonian line is a great value and it makes for the perfect every day wine.

Tasting Notes

Sweet aromas of ripe plums and dark cherries with hints of black pepper and raspberry. The palate offers flavors of raspberry, cherry, strawberry with hints of licorice on the finish. This is a medium body red wine.
