2021

The 2021 growing season started with a mild Winter that turned into a warm Spring. Bud break and bloom were earlier than the previous year by at least two weeks. Early Summer was warm and dry with conditions changing to warm and wet by August. As September approached, disease pressure was high and getting higher throughout the harvest. Careful attention was needed in the vineyard and in the cellar to ensure high quality.

Harvest Dates October 6, 2021

Vineyard:

Nutt Road Vineyard

Winemaking Notes: The fruit was field sorted to ensure that clean fruit was machine picked. The juice was fermented in stainless steel tanks and then aged in a combination of large format barrel and stainless steel tank.

Bottling Date: June 17, 2022

Tasting Notes: Aromas and flavors of pear, citrus, apple and parsley. The wine presents itself as delicate, yet its length and enjoyment is long and persistent.
